### Textbook

I will cover Sections 2-19. You must review the topics in Section 1 by yourself before the first class.

The study guide and its second volume are available at the ALICOS Copy Centre (the southeast corner of College and St. George).

This course covers about 30% of Exam MLC's syllabus. In order to write Exam MLC, you will need to take both ACT348 and ACT455. The official textbook for Exam MLC is **Actuarial Mathematics**, Second Edition, published by the Society of Actuaries, but it is not required for this course.

### Tests and Final Exam

There will be two term tests and a final exam. Each term test accounts for 25% of the final mark and the final exam accounts for 50% of the final mark. The term tests are 50 minutes long and given during the class time. The dates of the tests are February 12 and March 18. The final exam will be held during the faculty exam period. There will be no homework but I will assign many practice problems from the Study guide every two weeks. They will be posted at my website.
